Let's Get Walking! Gait in Paediatrics

with Suzanne Davis Bombria, PT, C/NDT

Course Description

This evidence-based course covers the evaluation and treatment of gait in children from a Contemporary NDTA™ perspective. Analyze the components and synergies associated with gait, from the acquisition of gait and its underlying components, to the challenge of changing gait in children with a well-established pattern. Clinicians will increase both their knowledge base and hands-on skills in order to further the child's functional and participation level. Course instruction will include lecture, lab, video case studies, and live demonstrations.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, participants will:

- Relate critical movement components for the development of pre-gait and gait skills
- Differentiate the phases of gait, how to measure, and the dynamic and mechanical elements of gait
- Critique pre-gait and gait patterns of typical children
- Examine key aspects of developmental biomechanics, kinesiology and alignment for the acquisition of standing and walking
- Analyze gait and differentiate between variety of causes, including identification of multi-system and single system strengths and impairments
- Explain and prioritize a minimum of the top 4 components needed for development of a focused treatment plan designed to improve function in a given child
- Defend treatment ideas with evidence
- Demonstrate 4 treatment strategies designed to improve components of gait

Suzanne Davis Bombria, PT, C/NDT is an internationally recognized and respected clinician, teacher and consultant in the treatment of children with neuromuscular impairments. Additionally, she brings first-hand practical experience to her courses as she is the mother of a son who has cerebral palsy. She is a Neuro-Developmental (NDT) Coordinator-Instructor for the intensive Contemporary NDTA™ Certification course in paediatrics for physical, occupational and speech therapists. She is one of the investigators in the project titled Multi-modal intervention for children with cerebral palsy: A randomized controlled trial at Southern Cross University in Australia. Cerebral Palsy Magazine, NDTA Network and Therapy Skill Builders have published her works. The passion for her work as a paediatric therapist and instructor, along with her easy presentation style, provide the theoretical and practical solutions all therapists can apply to their patient population.
